

### Starting a charge

Once you have downloaded the app, connect the cable to your vehicle. In the app, click on 'Find a charge point', locate the charge point and socket in the app you can find the socket number on the charger - and swipe to connect. Add your billing details and payment method to start the charge.

If you would like to register with us, click on 'Sign Up' and follow the instructions above. Registering gives you lower tariffs, instant access to charging, charging history, monthly billing and much more.

### **Stopping a charge**

To stop the charge, swipe stop in the app, wait for the charge to end, and disconnect the cable from your vehicle.

### Starting a charge

Connect the cable to your vehicle, follow the instructions on the charger screen, and hold your charge card on the charge card reader underneath the screen to start the charge.

### Stopping a charge

Hold your charge card on the card reader underneath the screen, select 'Stop' on the charger, and disconnect the cable from your vehicle.

Connect the cable to your vehicle, follow the instructions on the charger screen, and hold your payment card on the payment terminal to start the charge.


### Stopping a charge

Select 'Stop' on the charger, wait for the charge to end, and disconnect the cable from your vehicle.

# Speeds explained.



EVs charge quickly on ultra-rapid chargers – up to about 80% full. From 80-100% the charging rate is greatly reduced to protect the battery, as when a battery is nearly full, heat builds up in the cells. To keep temperatures down, the car reduces the incoming charge significantly with the last kWh added at very low speeds.

### Why am I not receiving the maximum speed?

The charging speed you receive depends on several things including:

- The grid and the availability of > charge at peak times
- Your car battery and the speed of charge it can receive >

### Why have I been charged a preauthorisation fee?

We put a hold on your payment card (contactless and pay-as-you-charge) to make sure you have the necessary funds to use our network. The payment never leaves your account, but it may temporarily show as a pending payment on your bank account.

### How long will it take to charge my car?

You can use the <u>EV Charging Time Calculator</u> to estimate how long it will take to charge your car according to your battery size, your starting and targeted charge level, and the charging power available.
